I'm an avid podcast listener and a career development nerd. And since 2015 I've hosted the podcast, *Find Your Dream Job* to provide listeners with practical, actionable job search and career advice.

Since starting my own show, I've discovered a small – but growing – community of other podcasters dedicated to helping people find meaningful, rewarding work. These hosts produce great shows, focusing on tactics that help you get hired and build the career you want.

Unfortunately, it's not easy to find all of this amazing content. There are over 500,000 shows currently on Apple Podcasts and, even under the "Career" category, job search podcasts are often lost in a sea of programs focused on investing, personal productivity, coaching, real estate, and entrepreneurship.

Last year, I decided we all needed a better way to find great career podcasts. So I created my inaugural *Top Career Podcasts Guide*: a single source for the best shows dedicated to helping professionals look for work and grow their careers. I continually explore the catalog of podcasts to identify the best shows for people looking for work, and I'm amazed at how it grows each year! That's why I'm so excited to present my second annual guide to career podcasts.

This year there are 78 shows included in my *Top Career Podcasts Guide* – an increase of almost 50% <u>since the 2017 edition</u>. 35 new shows are on the list. Some of these programs launched in the last year; others were well-established but new to me. If your podcast is on this list for the first, or second time, congratulations! You're part of an awesome community.

Also, at the suggestion of multiple podcast fans, I've included several shows that are no longer in production. Even without new episodes, these programs offer quality content that is valuable for job seekers, so go explore those back catalogs!

Of course, the constant stream of new podcasts means that as soon as this guide is published, it will be out of date!
